



# Ray Busters

Curious about UV golf apparel? We shed some light on how it works.

**COMFORTABLE AND STYLISH**, UV clothing is the latest trend in sun protection. Some brands are using fabric that has a protective coating applied in a liquid bath. A more durable alternative is fabric with a high degree of weave density: The smaller the space between the fibers, the less likely it is that UV rays will penetrate to the skin. We recommend layering for even more coverage, and since most of the pieces wick away moisture, you'll stay cool as well as covered up.

**SHIELD YOUR FACE WITH A SERIOUS VISOR**  
Physician Endorsed's Naples visor blocks up to 99 percent of UVA and UVB rays and has an extra-wide brim. \$33.

**PULL ON A MOISTURE-WICKING LONG-SLEEVE TOP**  
Coolibar's classic polo is made of a high-density cotton Coolmax weave that physically blocks UV rays. \$50.

**LAYER ON A POLO FOR ADDED SUN-BLOCKING**  
Adidas Golf's ClimaCool plaid polo has a UV protectant that shields your skin won't. \$60.

**SHORTS OR PANTS**  
Woven long shorts come in a variety of colors and patterns. \$64.
